Madison Avenue Replacement of Existing Retaining Walls

CLEVELAND – Effective Monday, June 6, 2011, Madison Avenue will be closed to all traffic, between West 112th Street and Berea Road. This closure will allow for the replacement of the retaining walls leading up to the rail overpass. Work includes concrete wall replacement, new sidewalk, and drainage improvements. This work is anticipated to be completed by November 2011.

This traffic advisory will remain in place until November 2011. Detour signs will be posted. Expect additional notices as work progresses that will impact traffic flow.

Posted detour route utilizes West 117th Street, Western Avenue, West 110th and Berea Road.

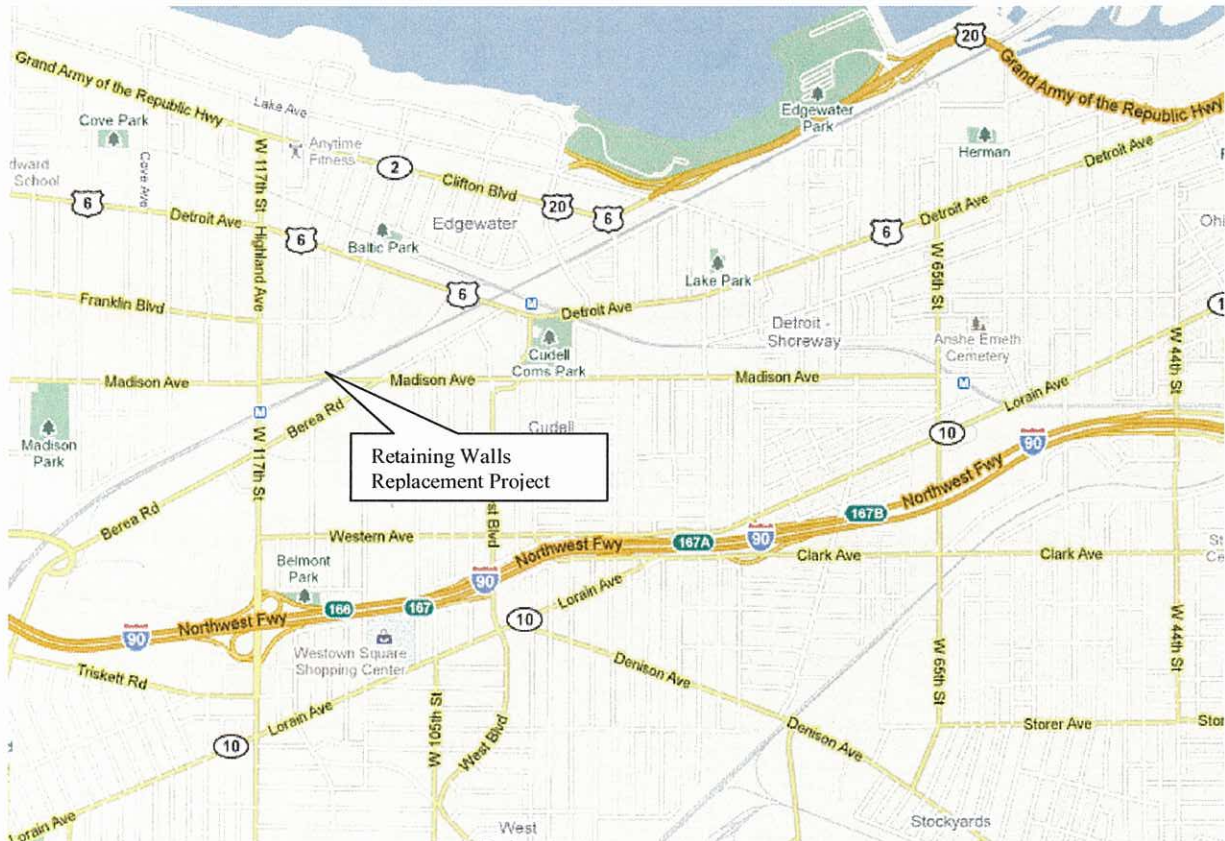
