Learn How the Police Work

Individuals who live or work in the City of Cleveland are invited to sign up for the Cleveland Citizen Police Academy.

Classes will be held once a week for 3 hours per class. Class sizes will be limited to 25 participants. There is no fee to attend.

Instruction will be provided by qualified instructors from the Cleveland Division of Police. Students will be provided with all necessary training materials.

Eligibility

The Citizen Police Academy is open to any person meeting the following requirements:

- ◆ Must be over the age of 18
- ◆ Must reside or work in the City of Cleveland
- ◆ Must complete the application process, which includes providing proof of identification (drivers license, state identification card, passport etc.), and record check
